

JUDGEMENT AND ORDER

1. This is an application by trustees of the above referred trust for amending the Scheme settled for the better management of the trust vide Orders dated 24/08/1984, in the Scheme Proceeding No. 53/1984. The said order was passed by the then Joint Charity Commissioner, Pune Region, Pune. This inquiry is being held under the provisions of the B.P.T. Act, 1950 under Section 50A(3) and Rules there under. The inquiry is uncontested.
2. The case of the applicant trustees in short, is that the administration of the Scheme settled by the Joint Charity Commissioner on 24/08/1984, the trustees are facing the difficulties in convincing the authorities to the effect that the trust has educational and medical objects only. The Scheme provides in clause No. 5 some such objects which may be



trustees while administrating the trust had never considered taking such objects on hands and carrying them out. From the existence of the trust, the educational and medical objects have been enhanced from time to time and now there are schools, colleges in various fields of education. This work is so large and huge that the trustees do not have any time to apply their mind and energy for achieving other objects other than the educational objects. While administrating the trust, these objects came into their way of smooth working and they are required to spend the trust funds, even if they do not consider undertaking the other works. They are, therefore, moving this authority for changes in the objects of the trust and they are also changes in the Rules of the Scheme. They are also moving the authority to include the preamble to the Scheme so that it is made clear as to the trust is settled, by whom it is settled, how it is managed, how it is caters the things to all in the society. They have, therefore, made the application to amend the Scheme.

3. The questions before me for my consideration and answers on the said questions are as follows:-

QUESTIONS

1. Whether it is necessary to Amend the Scheme?

ANSWER

Yes

2. If yes what should be the Amendment?

The amendments in various clauses especially object clause and addition of preamble in the Scheme.

3. What Order?

As per order below

REASONS FOR FINDINGS

Dr. J. J. Magdum Trust, Jaysingpur is a Public Trust registered vides orders dated 07/12/1977. This trust is registered at P.T.R. No. E-902 (Kolhapur). It is seen that the trust has been settled by Dr. J. J. Magdum and by Sou. Dr. Prabhavati J. Magdum of Jaysingpur by setting aside certain amounts in the trust has undertaken various activities in education and medical fields and has started schools, colleges, hospitals etc. The in-



folds and it is about Rs. 50 lacks per year for the present. The properties have also been acquired and the worth of the property both movable and immovable is about 1 crore 14 lacks 51 thousands. Thus this figure does show that the trust has acquired the properties during its existence and has been catering the needs of the Society in education and medical fields. It is seen that the trust has not carried out any other objects than the educational and medical objects. The trustees i.e. applicant Nos. 1,2,3 and 4 are the trustees, since the inception of the trust and applicant No. 5 is appointed on the death of Bhima Rama Nangre.

Thus, the present applicants are the trustees of the trust in question.

Dr. J. J. Magdum is present before me today and is examined in support of his application of Ex. 1. He has stated that the resolutions have been passed by the trustees on 30/04/1992 deletion of objects which are not educational objects & certain changes in clause Nos. 15(4) and 17. The trustees have passed resolution for incorporating preamble in respect of the trust and the amendment thereafter under the Scheme. The trustee has stated before me that these resolutions have been passed. He has accepted the contents of the application at Ex. 1 as correct. He has also identified signatures of the trustees on the application. He has moved this authority to amend the Scheme for smooth and proper working of the trust.

It is a fact that the trust has carried out its educational activities at Jaysingpur and has started (1) Jayprabha English Medium School (2) Jayprabha Junior College (3) Polytechnic (4) Dr. J. J. Magdum Homoeopathic Medical College (5) Dr. J. J. Magdum College of Engineering (Degree) (6) Dr. J. J. Magdum College of Diploma in Pharmacy.

There are hostels attached to these various Institutions also. Hospital is attached to the Medical College started by the trust. It is seen from the accounts submitted that the trustees have carried out the educational and medical objects and have not considered carrying out any other objects mentioned in the Scheme.



to pay the contribution and incur some expenses because of the inclusion of these objects even if they are not being carried out and even when the trustees do not consider undertaking these activities other than the educational and medical activities. I see that there is no reason to continue these objects in the object clause of the trust and hence I accept the prayer in respect of the amendments in the objects of the trust and delete the Clause no. 5 Sub clause 12, 13 and 19 in the Scheme previously settled.

There are other amendments which are in respect of the accounts for the year ending 31st March every year. The Scheme provided that the accounting year should be ending of 31st December. This requires change. I, therefore, accept the said amendment suggested by the applicants. Similarly is the case in respect of increase in the cash balance in hand. At the time of framing the Scheme in the year 1984, the amount was fixed of Rs. 500/-. It is seen that the trust has increased its activities many fold and acquired the properties thereafter and therefore it is necessary to increase this limit. The trustees have suggested to increase this limit to Rs. 5,000/-. I say no objection for this amendment also. I, therefore, accept the said amendment, and amend the Scheme accordingly.

This trust is stated to have been established by two settler's viz. Dr. J. J. Magdum and Prabhavati J. Magdum of Jaysingpur. Both these persons belong to Jain Chaturtha Dharma and other trustees being applicant Nos. 3 to 5 are also of the same religion. The said trust is an established by the settlers of particular religion and the trust has been managed and is being managed by the people of the said sect. The applicant trustees have moved this authority to include the preamble to the Scheme in order to get the advantages if any that can be accrued to the trust, I see no objection for inclusion of said preamble. In support of the inclusion of this preamble, Dr. J. J. Magdum has given his oral evidence in respect of the religion of the various trustees and settlers from time to time. I therefore, have finalized the preamble accordingly and have finalized the revised Scheme as per the annexure 'A' to this order.



ORDER

Application is granted. The Scheme is amended by including the preamble and by amending the object clause No. 5 and clause No. 15(4) and clause No. 17. The amendment would be as per the order above. The amended constitution shall be as per the annexure 'A' to this order.

The Scheme may be get implemented through the Competent Court, if found necessary. The trustees are directed to implement the Scheme so amended henceforth. They are also directed to see that they use the name of the trust as is mentioned in the said Scheme. No orders as to costs.

SUPPLEMENT

The amended Scheme under Section 50 A(3) as per order dated 23/03/1993 in Scheme No. 27/93 which is sanctioned by the office of Joint Charity Commissioner Pune Division Pune dated 24/08/1984 under Section 50 (A) (1) of Bombay Public Trust Act in the application No. 53/84 for proper management and administration of the Public Trust named Dr. J. J. Magdum Trust, Jaysingpur, Tal - Shirol, Dist - Kolhapur which is registered trust no. E - 902 (Kolhapur).

Preface

We all the trustees applied by application No.53/1984, under Section 50 (A) (1) of Bombay Public Trust Act 1950 and the said trust was registered by Trust Register No. P.T.R. No. E - 902 (Kolhapur).

We all (trustees) have decided to work in education field. So we started first the Pre-primary School, then Primary School, High School, Polytechnic College. Thus the work of trust is expanded. So we got sanctioned a new Scheme on 12/09/1984. And though by that we started the work of education. Till today we started Polytechnic College in the year 1984, Homoeopathic College in 1990, Junior College in 1992, Engineering College in 1992, D. Pharmacy College in 1993. Jaysingpur is the well planned city which is established by Shahu Maharaj. There are so many villages around the city and the purpose was to enlarge all kind of education to them.

All the trustees belong to Digamber Chaturtha Jain Community. And they all are the founder members of the trust. They are from minority. It is the only purpose to propagate educational and medical work to the common people.

1) Name of Trust and its register number:-

This public trust is named as "Dr. J. J. Magdum Trust".

This trust is registered in the office of Public Trust Registration Office at Kolhapur vice No. P.T.R. No. E - 902 (Kolhapur).



2) Office of Trust:-

The office of this Public Trust is at Jaysingpur, Tal - Shirol, Dist - Kolhapur. And if the members of trust want to change the place of trust, they can do it by passing resolution by majority. The Changed address should be registered in the office Public Trust Registration Office Kolhapur by the trust.

3) Property of Trust:-

All the movable and immovable properties mentioned in the register of Trust and mentioned in the register maintained under Section 36 B of the Trust Act 1950 are deemed to be the properties of this Public Trust. And also those properties which are not registered by an oversight or by any other reason are also deemed to be included in trust property. The growth or development in the property, the income or proceeds of the trust, donation, Gift etc all those type of the properties are mentioned in the rule / code as "Trust Property."

4) The ownership and possession of Trust Property:-

All the movable and immovable property of the Trust be in possession of the board of trustees and the management made by trustees which are appointed as per the rules framed or in possession of the board of trustees appointed in future.

All the actions may be made by the board of trustees as per the rules framed by P.T.R. Act 1950 and as per the P.T.R. Code 1950.

5) Objects of the Trust:-

- 1) By facilitating education to public and advancing it to propagate the education.
- 2) To establish the Primary Schools, Colleges, Pre-primary Schools, Technical Colleges, Engineering College, Medical College, Research Centre etc and by running them to give and propagate the education.



- 3) To take in hand the Pre-primary School, Primary School, Secondary School, Colleges established by other institutes to run.
- 4) To produce the literature and educational books to Create the national ideal on the students, and to publish them or to encourage the students to publish them.
- 5) To create patriotism earnestness, Self Respect, Self Dependence and Charitability in solving difficulties in the students of schools run by trust.
- 6) To make available concession in hostel charges etc and to make available Scholarship, Educational Loans and other facilities to poor, scholar and promising students.
- 7) To establish Hostel and to handover it to run.
- 8) To run and to takeover to run other educational Institutions.
- 9) To establish Libraries and to propagate the public education by mean of those libraries and to provide books free of cost to poor and needy students.
- 10) To provide medical help to all poor people and also to provide financial help to the people suffering from natural calamities, famine etc.
- 11) To do all necessary work for fulfilling above mentioned objects.
- 12) To publish the educational & sociological books and to provide them to needy persons for a nominal cost.
- 13) To make meal arrangement etc for the students residing in hostel.
- 14) To establish Clinics & Hospitals at various places and to run them.
- 15) To provide free medical to poor & needy persons.
- 16) To provide medical help to poor & needy persons.
- 17) To establish gymkhana and to run it. And to make available to do exercise to students. To make available the facility of ground. To create a liking of games. To encourage to play games and help them.



6) About the cancellation of post of trusteeship:-

- 1) If the trustee wishes to retire or gives registration or dies.
- 2) If he is unable to work as trustee due to his physical problem.
- 3) If he is convicted under moral crime by Criminal Court or he is convicted by Criminal Court under the rules framed under Bombay Public Trust 1950.
- 4) If he becomes mad or suffering from mental or physical infirmity.
- 5) If he declared as insolvent.
- 6) If he resides for 6 months out of India without the prior permission of Charity Commissioner. If he remains absent for 3 consecutive meetings conducted by trust.
- 7) If the demeanor of a trustee is against the interests of the trust his post may be cancelled by the majority.
- 7) The trustee No. 1 & 2 of trust board to remain lifetime trustee. And right to appoint 3 other trustees will remain to lifetime trustees.

The number of trustees shall be minimum 3 and maximum 5 in board of trustee.

If the post of trustee becomes vacant due to any reason that can be filled by the majority of the remaining trustees. However in board of trustees there shall be continuously two trustees from the family of Dr. J. J. Magdum. And one of them should be a president of the board of trustee and other should be vice president. The lifetime trustee can dismiss any trustee from his post.

8) The functions and rights of Board of Trustee:-

- i. All the rights of administration of Trust are vested in the board of trustees.
- ii. All the rights of the financial & immovable are vested in the board of trustee.
- iii. To take or give the property on lease as per the necessity for the work of trust and to use it under rights of board of trustee.



- iv. The right to make the provision beneficial and useful for fulfillment of object of Trust and rights to do other legal duties and completing the documents of trust are vested in the board of trustee.
- v. No trustee can become the owner of the property owned in the name of trust, in his personal capacity. And whole right is vested in the board of trustee to expend money or any trust property for completing the object of the trust.
- vi. All property of Trust and record shall be in the name of Trust and Board of trustees shall lookafter its administration.
- vii. The right to take action about the vacant post in the board of trustee shall vest in remaining trustees.
- viii. This trust is of minority people coming from the Jain Chaturth Community from its registration. And the trust should take advantage of it.

9) Duties of the Board of Trustee:-

- i. To do all necessary work for fulfilling the objects of the trust.
- ii. To execute the objects of the trust.
- iii. To take care and administer to manage all the property of trust.
- iv. To expend the money for fulfilling the objects of the trustee in proper way.
- v. To accept and demand donations, contributions, grants etc.
- vi. To carry out all transactions, programs in disciplined manner by making rules and documents by passing resolution and by executing the same.

10)

Power and rights vested in newly appointed trustee:-

When the new trustees are appointed as per the procedure mentioned above, their names may immediately be recorded to the properties in the name of trust or in the name of trustees and in possession of them as they are in which condition on that very time. Those properties may handed over them as those can be legally and effectively in joint possession of all the trustees of board.



The newly appointed trustee may be vested all the powers and rights as vested in all other trustees. But the newly appointed trustee cannot work as a trustee of the trust until he signed with his consent in the note book of Board of Trust.

11) Property Register:-

The board of trustee has to keep/maintain the register as per Section 36 B of Bombay Public Trust Act 1950. This register should contain the entries of all movable and immovable properties owned by trust with full description. At least two trustees have to inspect this register at least once in the year and signed duly by them.

12) General Meeting:-

- i. General meeting shall be called within 3 months after ending of financial year. Out of the all trustees 2/3 trustees should be present for fulfilling quorum. If the strict instruction mentioned in the invitation card then quorum is not necessary.
- ii. The notice of the General Meeting shall be issued to all trustees before minimum 15 days by post or in person. It should contain time, venue & subjects before the meeting.

13) Subjects before the General Meeting:-

- i. To read over the details of the last meeting and to confirm them.
- ii. To read over the accounts of tally, report and auditor's report at the last year and confirm them.
- iii. To appoint the auditor and his remuneration for the next year.
- iv. To read the budget prepared for the New Year and confirm it. To decide to take in hand the programs for New Year.

14) General Meeting on request:-

Secretary may call general meeting on written request by 1/3 trustees at trust. Except those subjects



mentioned in the invitation card other subjects cannot be considered in such meeting.

15) The office bearers and their duties:-

* President:-

Dr. J. J. Magdum shall be the lifetime president of this trust. In his absences or after his demise the legal heir of his family shall be appointed as a president and this appointment will be by hereditary and his span will be up to his lifetime. No one except legal heirs can be appointed as president. The rights and duties of the said president shall be as under-

- a) To honor a position of President of all the meetings called by Trust.
- b) To run meeting and decide subjects, proceedings, agenda of the meeting and also decide time, venue and date of the meeting.
- c) To call meeting for emergency proceeding.
- d) President shall have one additional vote in addition to his own vote. In the event of equal division of voting on any subject he can use his additional vote.
- e) To keep watch on the daily affairs.

* Vice President:-

In absence of the President the Vice President will honors the position of President of the meeting only to the extent of that meeting.

* Secretary:-

The rights & duties of Secretary shall be as under-

- a) To call meeting with the consent of President. To maintain the proceeding book. To read over it in next meeting and take signature of the president on it.
- b) To keep watch on the property of trust.
- c) To implement the decision in all the meetings of the Trust as per rules.
- d) To prepare yearly report and to make all correspondance. To maintain all record.



- e) To do all other work as per order of the board of trustee.

* **Treasurer:-**

The duties of treasurer are as under-

- a) To keep accounts of the trust by the consent and order of the board of trustee.
- b) To keep ready the books of tally of accounts and day book and ledger book.
- c) To manage and see all the financial transactions with the consent of President.
- d) Treasurer cannot keep the amount more than 5000/- in his hand.
- e) The bank account will be jointly in the name of President, Treasurer and Secretary.
- f) The bank transactions may be done by the signatures of two out of three but the signature of President is necessary.
- g) To do other works with the order of board of trustee.

16) **Meetings of Board of Trustee:-**

- a) The meeting of board of trustee shall be called at least once within three months. This meeting is supposed to be General Meeting.
- b) If it required the meeting of board of trustee may be called at any time which will be presumed as a Special Meeting.
- c) Minimum one meeting should be called in the premises of the trust.
- d) The right to call meeting is given to Secretary with the prior permission of the President.
- e) The notice of this type of meeting should be send by post or served in person in such a manner that it will be served on trustees 48 hours in advance.
- f) The invitation card must disclose the time, date, venue and subjects in front of meeting and agenda.



17) Financial Year:-

The financial year of trust will be from 1st April to 31st March.

18) Accounts of The Trust:-

The accounts of the income & expenditures of the property of the trust should be kept by the board of trustee and prepare the tallies of the accounts of the financial year and to check it by the authorized auditor and should be granted by the meeting. And after that it will be produced in the office of concerned Deputy Charity Commissioner.

19) Transactions of the Bank Account:-

The accounts of Trust shall be in the name of President and Vice President. And they can operate the account. But the signature of President is must.

20) Property:-

In connection of Sale of property, mortgage, borrowing of loan etc the rights vested in the board of trustees to sale any of the property of trust or to purchase, mortgage, exchange or borrow or to dispose of by any other way with prior consent of the Hon'ble Charity Commissioner under Section 24 of Bombay Public Trust Act 1950 and Public Trust Regulation Rules of 1951.

21) The Register of Movable and Immovable Properties:-

There shall be one permanent register about the movable and immovable properties of the trust under Section 36 (B) of Bombay Public Trust Act. In that register all the list of movable & immovable properties. As per changes in the property its entry shall be made in the register time to time.

22) Funds:-

1. To raise funds by accepting donations.
2. By taking benefit of Government Schemes.
3. By accepting in cash from other trusts or grants.

By manner decided by the board of trustee.



23) Employees:-

A. The right vests in the board of trustee to appoint necessary employees on proper conditions for daily affairs of the trust. If required it has also the right to dismiss an employee.

B. It is the right of board of trustee to give permission to employee who is appointed for the service of Trust on proper condition to reside in the building of trust without cost or on nominal fee.

24) Trustees of the Board of trustee having no interest in Trust:-

There shall not be any interest of the trustee in the property owned by the trust or in the income of the trust except the resolution passed and interest created as per the rules framed by the trust.

25) Right to make rules and byelaws:-

The right to make rules and byelaws and to execute them is vested in the board of trustee for the well management and administration of the trust as per the provisions made under this code. But those may not be against the rules, byelaws and code of the Public Trust Registration Act 1950. The rule and byelaws made by this way can be changed or cancelled by the board of trustee.

The rule and byelaws framed cannot be executed until they are certified by The Deputy Charity Commissioner, Kolhapur.

26) Changes in Rules:-

No change can be made without sanction by me Charity Commissioner under Section 50(A)(3). And also there can not be any execution without his sanction.

27) Proceeding Book:-

- 1] To give intimation of the meeting to trustees of the board of trustee. And to take their signatures.
- 2] To enter the proceedings of the meeting in proceeding book.
- 3] Further things may be entered in it.



- a) Names of present trustees and their signatures.
- b) Starting time of proceeding, dated & place.
- c) The minutes of the last meeting and the signature of its sanction.
- d) The decisions regarding the subjects mentioned in notice board. [Entries if notices - suggestive, secondary and decision]
- e) Subjects put for discussion at the very time of meeting. And the decisions on it.
- f) If any decision is made by circular, the entry of that decision.

28) Decisions regarding Rules:-

If there is any dispute regarding any rules, or meaning of any section, thins done by rules or to be done its legality; in such cases the final decision given by the Charity Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai is binding on all trustees.







Dr. J.J. Magdum Trust's Homoeopathic Medical College, Jaysingpur- 416101, Dist. Kolhapur is functional since 1993 and has applied for permission for sanction of BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and for MD (Hom.) with intake capacity of total 24 seats in 04 subjects namely Homoeopathic Materia Medica with 06 seats, Organon of Medicine with 06 seats, Repertory with 06 seats & Practice of Medicine with 06 seats for the academic year 2025-26. The college has submitted Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH conducted inspection on 02.06.2025 & 03.06.2025, followed by physical hearing on 30.06.2025 & virtual visitation on 02.07.2025. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 & 28 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls:

1. Deficiency of Teaching Faculty:

- In Department of Physiology 1 Associate Professor is deficient.
- In Department of Homoeopathic Materia Medica 1 Professor is deficient.
- In Department of Practice of Medicine 1 Associate Professor & 1 Assistant Professor are deficient.

2. Miscellaneous:-

- Pay scale of all the teaching staff is not according to MES- 2024.
- NABH accreditation of hospital is not available.
- NABL accreditation is not available.

3. During virtual visitation of the college on 02.07.2025, link was sent two times, first at 10:00 am & then at 04:00 pm to the college. From 10:00 am to 10:30 am college authority didn't join. Even after repeated calls college didn't join and kept on giving excuses to join after some time. At 04:00 pm link was again given to the college and vice principal joined but again disconnected and didn't join further for 10 minutes. It seems college was not interested in showing the hospital and college functioning, raising serious doubt about the genuine functioning of hospital and college.



4. Considering the above observations during physical inspection, hearing and virtual visitation, MARBH has decided to issue permission to Dr. J.J. Magdum Trust's Homoeopathic Medical College, Jaysingpur- 416101, Dist. Kolhapur for continuing UG (BHMS) course with intake capacity of 70 seats (reduced from 100) for academic year 2025-26.
5. MARBH has decided to give denial to the college for MD (Hom.) course with intake capacity of total 24 seats in 04 subjects namely Homoeopathic Materia Medica with 06 seats, Organon of Medicine with 06 seats, Repertory with 06 seats & Practice of Medicine with 06 seats for the academic year 2025-26.
6. All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of (70 seats) BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT designated by Central Government. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India Quota or the student admitted thereunder.
7. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
8. If the College is aggrieved by any decision of the Autonomous Board, college may prefer an appeal to the Commission against such decision within 30 days of the communication of such decision as per National Commission for Homoeopathy (Assessment and Rating of Medical Institutions) Regulations 2024, section 14 subsection (1) and NCH General Regulation 2023 section 22. The Manner of instructions for appeal are attached.
