**Sub :** Application for letter of permission for functioning of Dr. J.J. Magdum Trust's Homoeopathic Medical College, Jaysingpur- 416101, Dist. Kolhapur for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and for MD (Hom.) with intake capacity of total 24 seats in 04 subjects namely Homoeopathic Materia Medica with 06 seats, Organon of Medicine with 06 seats, Repertory with 06 seats & Practice of Medicine with 06 seats for the academic year 2025-26 - regd.

Sir,

Dr. J.J. Magdum Trust's Homoeopathic Medical College, Jaysingpur- 416101, Dist. Kolhapur is functional since 1993 and has applied for permission for sanction of BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and for MD (Hom.) with intake capacity of total 24 seats in 04 subjects namely Homoeopathic Materia Medica with 06 seats, Organon of Medicine with 06 seats, Repertory with 06 seats & Practice of Medicine with 06 seats for the academic year 2025-26. The college has submitted Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH conducted inspection on 02.06.2025 & 03.06.2025, followed by physical hearing on 30.06.2025 & virtual visitation on 02.07.2025. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 & 28 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls:

**1. Deficiency of Teaching Faculty:**

- In Department of Physiology 1 Associate Professor is deficient.
- In Department of Homoeopathic Materia Medica 1 Professor is deficient.
- In Department of Practice of Medicine 1 Associate Professor & 1 Assistant Professor are deficient.

**2. Miscellaneous:**


- Pay scale of all the teaching staff is not according to MES- 2024.
- NABH accreditation of hospital is not available.
- NABL accreditation is not available.

- During virtual visitation of the college on 02.07.2025, link was sent two times, first at 10:00 am & then at 04:00 pm to the college. From 10:00 am to 10:30 am college authority didn't join. Even after repeated calls college didn't join and kept on giving excuses to join after some time. At 04:00 pm link was again given to the college and vice principal joined but again disconnected and didn't join further for 10 minutes. It seems college was not interested in showing the hospital and college functioning, raising serious doubt about the genuine functioning of hospital and college.

4. Considering the above observations during physical inspection, hearing and virtual visitation, MARBH has decided to issue permission to Dr. J.J. Magdum Trust's Homoeopathic Medical College, Jaysingpur- 416101, Dist. Kolhapur for continuing UG (BHMS) course with intake capacity of 70 seats (reduced from 100) for academic year 2025-26.
5. MARBH has decided to give denial to the college for MD (Hom.) course with intake capacity of total 24 seats in 04 subjects namely Homoeopathic Materia Medica with 06 seats, Organon of Medicine with 06 seats, Repertory with 06 seats & Practice of Medicine with 06 seats for the academic year 2025-26.
6. All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of (70 seats) BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT designated by Central Government. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India Quota or the student admitted thereunder.
7. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
8. If the College is aggrieved by any decision of the Autonomous Board, college may prefer an appeal to the Commission against such decision within 30 days of the communication of such decision as per National Commission for Homoeopathy (Assessment and Rating of Medical Institutions) Regulations 2024, section 14 subsection (1) and NCH General Regulation 2023 section 22. The Manner of instructions for appeal are attached.

Further, if the permission is declined by the said authorities, this Continuation / Extension of Affiliation shall be treated as cancelled. The College is not authorized to admit students for 1<sup>st</sup> Year of the course until receipt of permission of the National Commission for Homoeopathy / Government of India /Department of AYUSH, New Delhi.
